

# Suspended -> Restricted

Updated numbers from the Kansas Department of Revenue show that more than **213,000** Kansans have suspended licenses, about half of them from Sedgwick County and the City of Wichita. Around **71%** of these suspensions are a direct result of unpaid fines and court fees as opposed to nationwide being only **40%**. Disproportionately affects minorities. In some situations, drivers with suspended licenses are able to apply for a restricted license.

# Suspended -> Restricted

- A restricted license allows a person to drive:
  - To and from work and school
  - To and from drug or alcohol counseling
  - To and from an appointment with a healthcare provider or during a medical emergency
  - In the course of your employment
  - Any place you are required to go by a court
- 12 months to pay off fines and court fees
- \$25 to apply
- Form can be submitted online or mailed

# Am I Eligible to Apply for a Restricted License?

- You must have a Kansas Driver's License
- Your status must be "Suspended"
  - Status of "Revoked" is not eligible
  - Status of "Other" requires follow-up with Driver's Solutions
- You can't have a "Driving While Suspended" conviction
  - Resolve the sentence for this conviction prior to applying
- Any reinstatement fees must be paid before applying
- Must have car insurance if you own a vehicle
  - Driving without insurance
  - Release of Liability
- DUIs are much more complicated

# Release of Liability & Driving Without Insurance

- Was there an accident?
  - Release of liability required from ALL individuals involved.
- Were minors involved?
- Was government property damaged?
- Is there or has there been a lawsuit filed against you?
- Do you own a vehicle?
  - Do you have insurance now?

# **FAQs**

- My license is revoked, am I able to get a restricted license?
  - No, unfortunately once your license is revoked, you will have a
    waiting period of three years before you can get any valid license.
    The exact date you are eligible will show up in the driver's license
    status check.
- What do I need to do to get a restricted license?
  - First you will want to make sure you are eligible. You can do so by using our Guide Clearly tool under the Suspended License heading. If you are eligible, you can fill out the form the guide links you to.




Every ending will provide you with the source you need to move forward. If you qualify to apply for a restricted license, it will link you to the form (fee of \$25).

# FAQs (Continued)

- Once I have a restricted license, how do I get it unrestricted?
  - Restricted licenses allow you to have 12 months from the date you are granted a restricted license to pay off any and all outstanding court costs and fees. Once you successfully pay off all of your court costs and fees, you can get your unrestricted license. If you do not pay off all of your court costs and fees within 12 months, your restricted license will become suspended.
- Can I take my written driver's test online?
  - No. Although there are many practice tests and study resources, the written driver's test is only offered in person. Any online test or online driver's education course will not fulfill the test requirements to obtain a driver's license.




