Section 6. Notice of Move or Extended Absence

6.1 Each parent must give written notice to the other parent not less than 30 days before: (1) changing the residence of the child; or (2) removing the child from this state for a period of time longer than 90 days. The notice must be sent by restricted mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the other parent.

Failure to give notice is an indirect civil contempt punishable as provided by law. In addition, the court may assess, against the parent required to give notice, reasonable attorney fees and any other expenses incurred by the other parent by reason of the failure to give notice.

6.2 A parent is not required to give written notice of removal to the other parent under section 6.1 if the other parent has been convicted of a crime specified in Article 34 (crimes against persons), Article 35 (sex offenses), or Article 36 (crimes affecting family relationships and children) of Chapter 21 (Crimes and Punishments) of the Kansas Statutes Annotated to which the child(ren) was the victim.

Section 7. Notice to Other Parent of Registration or Conviction

- 7.1 A parent must send written notice to the other parent by restricted mail, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the other parent within 14 days after the parent:
 - (1) is subject to the registration requirements of the Kansas offender registration act (K.S.A. 22-4901 et seq.), or any similar act in any other state, or under military or federal law;
 - (2) has been convicted of abuse of a child (K.S.A. 21-5602);
 - (3) is residing with an individual who is known by the parent to be subject to the registration requirements of the Kansas offender registration act (K.S.A. 22-
