Removal of Drug registry requirement for Kansans

Who is affected by this law change

2022 law (KSA 22-4908) allows those on the Drug Registry to Petition for removal of that requirement

What should I do before I apply?

- Check the offender registry for compliance
- Gather \$179 court filing fee or seek waiver of the filing fee
- Consider seeking an expungement of the conviction at the same time

What is the Process?

What information is required in the Petition?

- All treatment programs and providers
- Statement about you current situation

What happens after the Judge signs the order?

Should I file for expungement at the same time as relief from registration?
